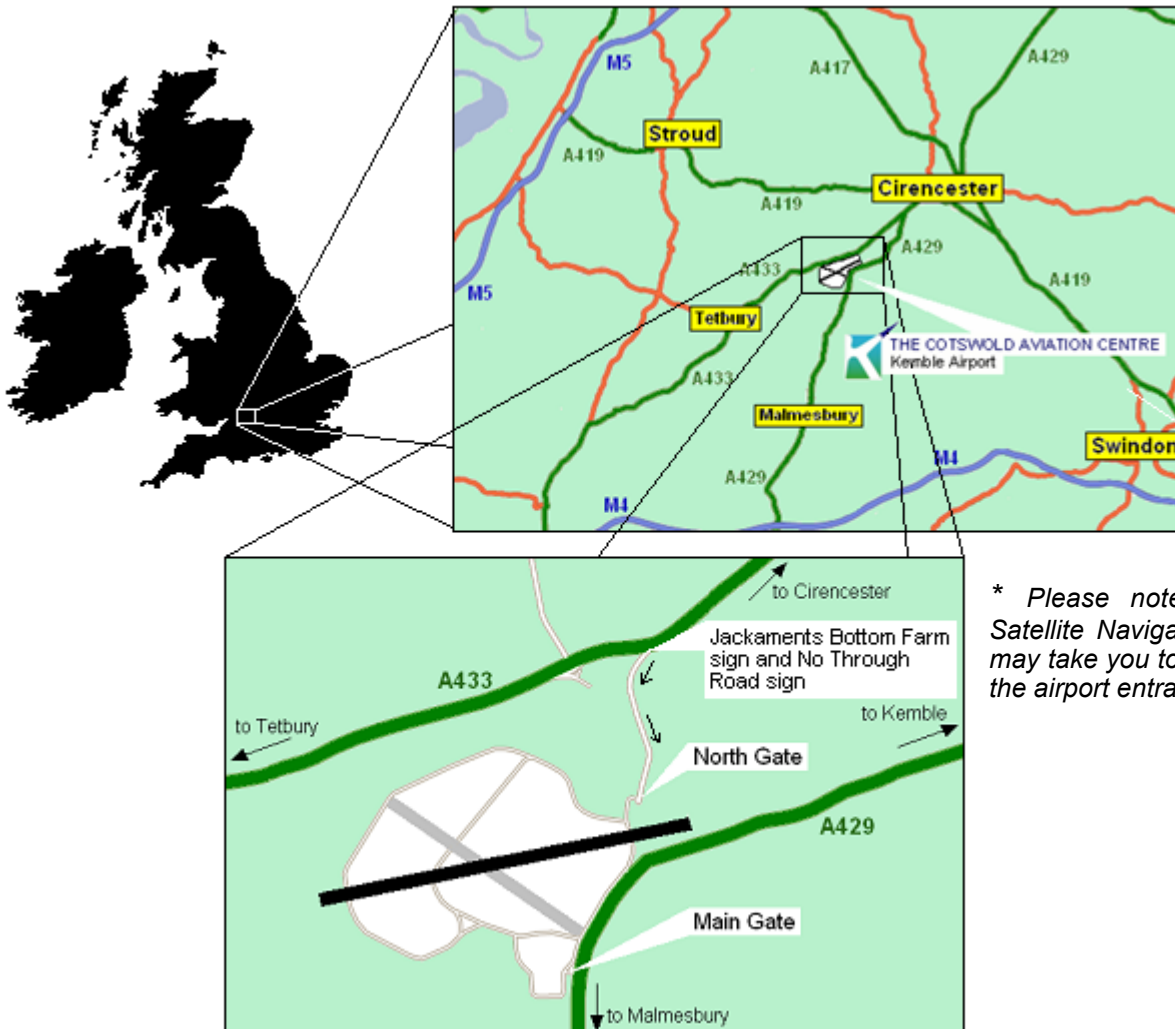


HH Helicopters are based at:

* Please note that if you use a Satellite Navigation System/GPS, this may take you to Rodmarton and not to the airport entrance.

From the East (London, M25 etc)

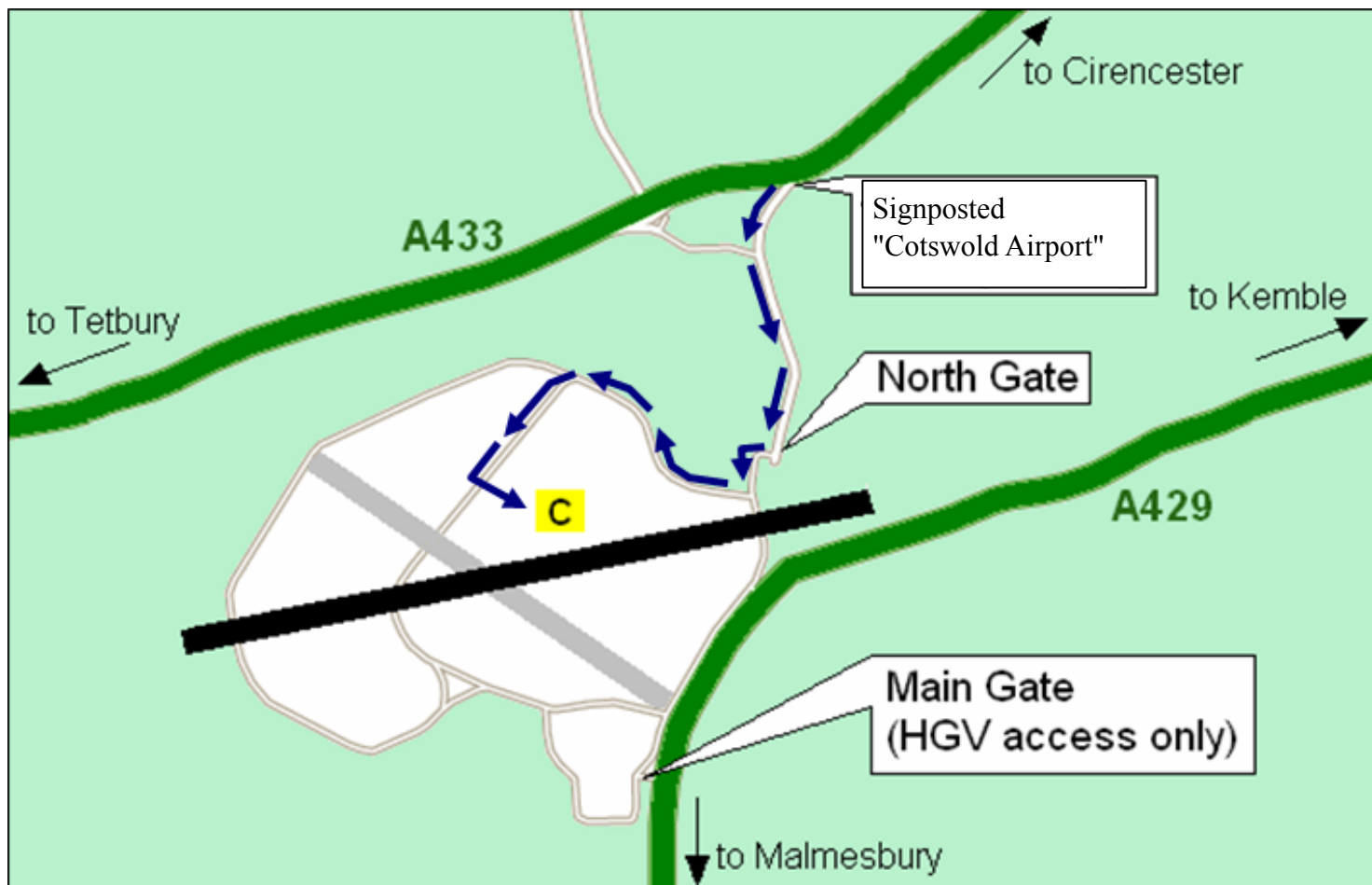
- Take the M4 to junction 17, and then follow the A429 north towards Cirencester. Please do not exit at junction 15 as it is easy to get lost and is no faster this way.
- Though you will see Cotswold Airport on the left hand side, after Malmesbury and Crudwell, you will not be able to gain access from this road.
- Continue on A429 towards Cirencester, past Cotswold Airport, and you will come to Kemble village.
- You will see a traffic light crossing in the middle of the village. Turn left here (signposted Coates) and follow under the bridge to the end of the road.
- At the T-junction turn left onto the A433. After about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile, you will approach a right hand bend with a small country lane turning off to the left. Turn into this road, signposted Cotswold Airport.

From the North

- There are several options, one of which is to take the M5 to Junction 11A and then the A419 to Cirencester.
- Once at Cirencester, take the A433 Tetbury Road. Follow the A433 towards Tetbury. You will pass under a railway bridge and The Thames Head pub on the right.
- Approximately $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles further you will approach a right hand bend with a small country lane turning off to the left. Turn into this road, signposted Cotswold Airport.

From the South West / Bristol

- Exit the M4 at J 18 and take the A46 towards Stroud
- Turn right onto the A433 towards Tetbury.
- At the mini roundabout in Tetbury, go straight over
- Follow the road until you reach a cross roads, turn right
- Follow this road until you see a right turn sign for Cotswold Airport.

- If you reach the Thames Head Pub, you've missed us, turn round!



- Once you have turned off the A433, follow the lane to the very end where you will see the entrance to the airport. The large metal gates should be open, but if not, please press the ATC buttons on the keypad, and they will open the gate for you.
- Once through this gate, follow the road and blue signs to Control Tower and AV8 Restaurant.
- As you enter the first car park you will see our red door ahead of you with the “Cotswold Helicopter Centre” sign.
